

## 2H GEORGE UNDERWOOD

2H. George Underwood ca (1772-1826)

1A. John Underwood (17??-1811) and Margaret Jackman Underwood of Wilkes and Surry Counties, North Carolina.

George Underwood followed his older brothers, William and John Underwood (2B and 2F). He came to Tennessee about 1802 and stopped at his brother, John Underwood's home in Sevier County. In 1803 he bought 100 acres of land from Joseph Smith in Knox County, Tennessee. It was "on the "limestone branch of Tuckahoe Creek" which is near the Sevier-Knox County line. The amount paid was three hundred dollars. The date was January 31, 1803.

The legend is that George Underwood was a hatter. He must have died before 1827 since his land was assessed to Sally Underwood in 1827 and 1828. He was buried in old Salem Cemetery near where he lived. In 1832 on Oct. 26, John Underwood entered acreage on Tuckahoe Creek adjoining "the heirs of George Underwood, dc'cd" 1

It is hard to determine the number of children in this family. It is reasonable to assume that there were four girls and three boys. There may have been more.

3A. Benjamin Underwood, b. before 1800; d. The only record is from Blount County Census 1830 031001-10101 According to the enumeration, there were three sons between ages 5 and 15 and two daughters between 5 and 15. Benjamin himself was between 30 and 40 and the wife was between 20 and 30. There are records of Benjamin Underwood's business dealings in Blount County but no records of himself or family unless these girls were his daughters:

Priscilla Underwood married Wm. Knight Jan. 16, 1823  
Eleanor Underwood married Nathan Padgett Mar. 13, 1823

There was a Carty Underwood listed in the 1830 census but no connection can be established with him belonging to the George Underwood family.

The entire family seems to have moved to Blount County after the death of the patriarch. Sally was listed as being between the ages of 50 and 60 and living with one female child under five years old in the household. She was living near her older children.

All were born in Tennessee. This family left Blount County in 1842 and it is reported that Zilphia died enroute To Illinois.

Bondsman Hiram Underwood in Knox County, Tennessee. This family went to Blount Co., Tn. They lived near the Mulvaneys and Sarah Underwood mentioned above. In the 1830 census, (2000001-112001) she was between 30 and 40 years of age. No further record has been obtained on this family. The Hammer family went to Blount County, but no record has been found as to where in that county they moved.

There were two other girls who the writer assumes were sisters of Hiram and Zilpha Underwood. They were married in Knox County, Tennessee, and before the family went to Blount and before the father, George Underwood, died. They were Mary Underwood who married Isaac Hammer Nov. 13, 1815, (bn Simon Adamson) and Jane Underwood who married Isaac Adamson July 28, 1821

Hiram Underwood's Will 3

I, Hiram Underwood of the County of Sevier and State of Tennessee, do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all former wills by me made at any time heretofore.

And first I direct that my body be decently interred at the burying ground at Salem in a manner suitable to my condition in life and as to such worldly estate as it has pleased God to entrust me with. I dispose of the same as follows:

First, I direct that all my past debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon as possible after my decease out of any monies that I may die possessed of or that may first come into the hands of my executors.

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Hiram Underwood's Will (cont'd)

It is my will that the proceeds of my farm and property and the use of the same be extended to the minor heirs until the youngest becomes of age after that time to the use and benefit of my beloved wife, Sarah (U?) Underwood during her widowhood and until her death if she should remain a widow or until that time. After her death or marriage it is my will that the lands and property be sold to the highest bidder and the proceeds of the sale divided among the lawful heirs of my estate. I do make and ordain my esteemed friend and neighbor Wm H. Oglesby and my beloved wife Sarah executors of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I the said Hiram Underwood have to this my last will and Testament written on one sheet of paper set my hand and seal this twenty-second day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six.

3? Benjamin Underwood, b.

This is a presumption based on scattered evidence found in various places in census and county court records.

In the Sevier County Census 1830 there is a Benjamin Underwood, age about thirty or less with no dependents and in the Blount County Census 1830 there is a Benjamin Underwood, age under 40 with three males under ten and one under fifteen and one female under five, one between ten and fifteen and one between twenty-five and thirty.

In entries 1815-1819 in Knox County Register of Deeds Office, there is an entry for twelve acres on the north side of French Broad River which included "the spring and house where John Underwood (2F) now lives" dated 10 Jan. 1817. This was witnessed by Benj. Underwood and Robt. Armstrong. Also, in the Knox Court Minutes a Benj. Underwood was appointed road overseer of a road from a point in Knox County to the mouth of Dumplin Creek.

In 1836-1839 Benj. Underwood did business with Samuel Henry in Blount County in Books N and B. there were Mortgages, deeds and bill of sales. This Benjamin Underwood must have been a son of George Underwood and was the principal reason that the family went to Blount County.

There was a female child under five years of age living with Sarah Underwood in Blount County in 1830. there is no record of and Angala or "Ange" Underwood in Sevier County, Tennessee in 1850. However, there was an Ange Underwood living in the Paw Paw Hollow section of Sevier County in the early 1900's. She had children.

The writer was discussing genealogy with his grandfather, Enoch Pleasant Underwood. He was trying to think of the name of the father of this family when he said that Ange would know since she was older than he (1838).
